### Interesting facts

In 2022 LBA had the **3rd best performance in the UK** compared to 2021 [of the Top 20 Airports in 2022] **+347.45%** and was the UK's 13<sup>th</sup> busiest airport **with** 3,287,968 passengers.

Five years ago LBA was the 13th busiest airport.

Aircraft Movements increased by 132% compared to 2021

There was an increase in passenger movements of 205.93% in 2022 compared to 2021. The figure for 2022 was 25943

There were 149,129 Domestic and 3,138,659 International Passengers. The domestic passengers increased by 93.93% compared to 2021 and International increased by 377.12%.

In 2022 there were flights to 74 different international destinations (Over 200 Passengers), compared to 47 in 2021. Alicante was the most popular followed by Palma, Malaga, Dublin. Tenerife, Faro, Arrecife and Amsterdam.

In 2022 there were 7 different domestic destinations, with the most popular being Belfast City followed by Belfast international, Jersey, Heathrow, Guernsey, Southampton and Newquay

The freight figure for 2022 was 0.15 Tonnes compared to 2021 which was 0.002 Tonnes
