Interesting facts

In 2013 LBIA was the **3rd fastest growing airport in UK (+12.64%)** and was the UK's 16th busiest airport with 3,314,395 passengers.

Five years ago LBIA was also the 16th busiest airport.

In 2013 Charter Passengers were just 4% of the total passengers. In 2012 it was 5.47%.

Aircraft Movements dropped by 3.55% compared to 2012 and was the lowest figure in the last 10 years

There was an increase in passenger movements of 0.56% in 2013 compared to 2012. The figure for 2013 was 30393

There were 61 diversions (75 in 2012) away from LBIA. Manchester received 31 followed by Liverpool (11), East Midlands (5) Doncaster (4), Durham Tees Valley (4) and others (6). LBIA also received 8 diversions (5 in 2012) from other airports. Both London City (231) and Heathrow (98) had

more diversions away than LBIA. The next airports were Bristol (61), East Midlands(60), Gatwick (44), Stansted (43) and then Manchester (39)

There were 373,010 Domestic and 2,940,591 International Passengers. The domestic passengers increased by 26.7% compared to 2012 and International increased by 9.98%

In 2013 there were flights to 84 different international destinations, compared to 78 in 2012. Malaga was the most popular followed by Palma, Alicante, Amsterdam, Dublin, Faro and Tenerife.

In 2013 there were 9 different domestic destinations, with the most popular being Belfast City followed by Heathrow, Southampton, Belfast International, Jersey, Aberdeen and Glasgow.

The freight figure for 2013 was 323 Tonnes, Up 15% when compared to 2012 and the highest since 2009
