Interesting facts

In 2014 LBA was the **3rd Worst airport in UK** [of the Top 20 Airports] **(-1.54%)** and was the UK's 16th busiest airport with 3,263,247 passengers.

Five years ago LBA was also the 16th busiest airport.

In 2014 Charter Passengers were 4.67% of the total passengers. In 2013 it was just 4%

Aircraft Movements dropped by 5.78% compared to 2013 and was the lowest figure in the last 10 years

There was a decrease in passenger movements of 1.7% in 2014 compared to 2013. The figure for 2014 was 29873

There were 67 diversions (61 in 2013) away from LBA. Manchester received 45 followed by Doncaster (11), Liverpool (4), Humberside (3) and others (4). LBA also received 9 diverts (8 in

2013) from other airports. Just London City (183) had more diversions away than LBA. The next airports were Bristol (57), Gatwick (57), Heathrow (47), Stansted (41) and then Birmingham (31)

There were 368,590 Domestic and 2,894,172 International Passengers. The domestic passengers decreased by 1.27% compared to 2013 and International decreased by 1.6%.

In 2014 there were flights to 81 different international destinations, compared to 84 in 2013. Amsterdam was the most popular followed by Palma, Malaga, Alicante, Dublin, Faro and Tenerife.

In 2014 there were 6 different domestic destinations, with the most popular being Belfast City followed by Heathrow, Southampton, Aberdeen, Jersey and Glasgow.

The freight figure for 2014 was 68 Tonnes, down 79% when compared to 2013 and the lowest for at least 10 years.
