Interesting facts

In 2017 LBA had the 2nd Best Airport increase in the UK [of the Top 20 Airports] (+12.82%) and was the UK's 15th busiest airport with 4,074,500 passengers.

Five years ago LBA was the 16th busiest airport.

In 2017 Charter Passengers were 3% of the total passengers. In 2016 it was 3.87%

Aircraft Movements Increased by 4.18% compared to 2016 and showed an increase for two years running

There was an increase in passenger movements of 8.97% in 2017 compared to 2016. The figure for 2017 was 34549

There were 436,119 Domestic and 3,638,381 International Passengers. The domestic passengers increased by 7.92% compared to 2017 and International increased by 7.12%.

In 2017 there were flights to 71 different international destinations (Over 200 Passengers), compared to 73 in 2016. Alicante was the most popular followed by Dublin, Malaga, Palma, Amsterdam, Faro, Tenerife and Arrecife.

In 2017 there were 8 different domestic destinations, with the most popular being Belfast City followed by Heathrow, Southampton, Newquay, Jersey and Guernsey
