An absolutely amazing month. International passengers increased by 52% when compared to a year ago. Even Charter passenger numbers increased by 5% and scheduled movements increased by 3% and charter movements by 38%. We are on course for a record breaking year!

There were only TWO routes that showed a decreased, unsurprisingly Sharm-el-Sheikh (-16%) and also Treviso in Italy (-0.61%). There were SEVEN routes that showed an increase in excess of 100%, with the best being Fuerteventura (+277%), Geneva (+156%), Tenerife (+136%) and Barcelona (+138%). Interestingly 5 routes didn't operate this year (Carcasson, Perpignon, Tel Aviv?, Gerona and Monastir in Tunisia). There were 5 new routes as well.

Domestic flights have become rather insignificant, accounting for less than 10% of the total passengers. Surprisingly SIX routes showed an increase, these being Plymouth (+166%), Belfast international (+36%), Belfast City (+30%), Glasgow (+18%), Edinburgh (+6%), and Southampton (+2%). Aberdeen, Gatwick and Newquay (except 6 passengers) didn't operate this year and if you exclude these routes we had a healthy 20%+ increase.

There were no diverts at all.
