A very similar month to June 2011, with passenger numbers increasing by 3.9% when compared to July 2010. Domestic dropped 18% and international increased by 6.7%. Interestingly scheduled movements dropped by 5.9%.

International routes performed well with 36 routes showing an increase, compared to only 12 showing a decrease. The best were Fuerteventura (+137%), Bodrum (+120%), Tarbes (106%)[Lourdes charters], Venice (+77%), Barcelona (+74%) and Arrecife (+72%). The worst were Rhodes (-49%), Geneva (-32%), Zakinthos (-17%), and Nantes (-12%). There were 7 routes that didn't operate this year and 5 new routes.

Domestically 3 routes showed an increase, Plymouth(+62%), Belfast City (+14%), and Jersey (+6%), which is ironic since Plymouth will soon be closing!. All the others showed a decrease ranging from Newquay (-89%) to Belfast International (-2%)

There was just one diversion away, to Manchester and we received one flight which should have gone to Newcastle
