A surprising month, in that the passenger numbers only increased by 3.23%, and is the lowest year on year increase since April 2010, Ryanair's first full month of operation as a based airline. Having said that the Moving Annual Total is the highest ever achieved at just under 3 million.

This month we had 51 different international routes, with 29 increasing compared to June 2010, 17 showing a decrease, 7 not running this year and 5 new routes. The routes with the highest increases are Fuerteventura (+108%), Barcelona (+80%), Venice (+72%) and Arrecife (+65%). The worst routes were Rhodes (-45%), Nantes (-20%), Heraklion (-17%) and Burgas (-14%).

Domestically, three routes increased, Plymouth (+82%), Jersey (+16%) and Belfast City (+10%). All the rest showed a decrease and Aberdeen and Gatwick didn't operator when compared to June 2010. The most popular route is to Belfast City (7707), followed by Belfast International (6314) and just two passengers behind is Southampton (6312).

Regarding diversions, we lost 4 flights to Manchester and gained one flight, a diversion from Southampton!
