The passenger numbers in term s of percentages compared to the previous year for September are almost identical to August with an overall increase in passenger numbers of 4.23%. Movements overall were down by almost 10%, but the Moving Annual Total has reduced to +11.66%

There were 52 different international routes with 17 showing a decrease and 30 showing an increase. There were six routes that didn't operate this year and five new routes. The most popular routes were Palma (30043), Malaga (27400), Alicante (26151), Amsterdam(21645), Faro (16942) and Dublin(14456)

Domestically 3 routes didn't operate Gatwick, Plymouth and Aberdeen. Four routes increased Newquay (+82%), Isle of Man (+22%), Belfast City (+19%) and Jersey (+3%) and the other six routes had a decline in passenger numbers

We lost six flights to diversions and we gained one flight that was intended to land overseas??
